Tri-Council Policy Statement: Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans (TCPS) Draft 2nd Edition 2008 to 1998 Edition

This Table is intended to facilitate a comparison between the draft 2nd edition of the *Tri-Council Policy Statement: Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans* (TCPS) and the 1998 edition of the document. The chapters of the 2008 draft were called Sections in the 1998 edition. The explanatory paragraphs following the articles are called Applications in the draft 2nd edition. They had no title in the 1998 edition, and are referred to in this document as “commentary”.

In this table, reference to an article in the 1998 edition of the TCPS is meant to include reference to the commentary of that article. Where reference is made to the commentary only, it is noted.

The table of concordance was created for ease of reference; there is not an exact correspondence between the two editions of the TCPS.
